HINTS ON MAKING A PARTY WITH BOSWICK A HUGE SUCCESS!

- ☞ Use name-tags for the children.
- ☞ Let your guests know what time Boswick will start his show.
- ☞ Feed the children before the show, kids won't eat once Boswick arrives.
- ☞ If there is a child that is afraid of clowns, let them watch Boswick from a distance. They will almost always join the other children. **DON'T FORCE THEM!**
- ☞ Boswick will have the children laughing, giggling and sometimes shouting. Let the children know that in this case It's ok to be a little noisy.
- ☞ Clear an area about 5x10, have Boswick with his back to a wall, children get easily distracted with things going on behind.
- ☞ If possible, kids are most comfortable sitting on the floor watching the show.
- ☞ If the party is outdoors, find a shady spot; bring a blanket in case the grass is wet.
- ☞ Don't give noisemakers to the children during the show.
- ☞ Get involved, Boswick does a family show, there is a lot of interaction with the adults as well as the kids. Kids love to see their parents laughing and being silly.
- ☞ When Boswick is done, it's best to move on to another big activity, (cake, presents, piñata).
- ☞ Turn on your cell phone **10 MINUTES** before you expect Boswick to arrive

Fun Activities!

Have kid's decorate their own cupcakes or cookies.

Have Kid's make their own goodie bags by using paper lunch bags, stickers, glitter glue and crayons.

Tape a long piece of butcher paper to the wall and have kids color in the word's "Happy Birthday" .
